This reference document may not cover all areas of your WebCT or eLearning courses. Course Area	Details
Assignment tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assignments migrate and the Assignments tool appears in the course menu under Course Tools.
Calendar tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Calendar tool added to the course menu under Course Tools.
Chat tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> General purpose rooms migrate and Chat appears in the course menu under Course Tools.
Compile utility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create Printable View: In eLearning, you can include a Create Printable View button allowing you to create a printable view of compiled content (Calendar, Discussions, Mail, Syllabus, in the Action Menu of Learning Modules and more).

Course Area	Details
<p>Content Module becomes Learning Module</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning Modules: WebCT Content modules migrate to eLearning Learning Modules. The Learning Module tool is added to the course menu, under Course Tools. • Links: The following types of links migrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Action menu links ○ Links from an organizer page to a content module ○ Glossary keyword links in pages of content <p><i>Note: links that are plural, past-tense and two lines may need to be reviewed and reestablished.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Links to files, audio, video, quizzes, self-tests, URLs and glossaries, migrate to links in the Action menu. • Text blocks: Upper/lower text blocks in WebCT content modules can be transferred to eLearning in two ways: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The information in the WebCT text blocks can be recreated in WebCT as web pages in order to migrate to eLearning. ○ The information in the WebCT text blocks can be added to the eLearning course as headers and footers following the migration. • Table of Contents location: Options for the location and appearance of the Table of Contents can be chosen in <i>Edit Properties</i>.
<p>Course Menu Links</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Single Page Links: Files linked to by Single Pages in WebCT can be found in the eLearning File Manager. Some links may need to be recreated if that were only linked to on Single Pages in WebCT. • Web Links: Links to URLs (web pages) on the Course Menu in WebCT will appear in the Web Links tool, in the eLearning Course Menu.
<p>Glossary tool becomes a collection in Media Library tool</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each keyword in the Glossary migrates to an entry in the Media Library collection "Glossary". Media Library appears under Course Tools.
<p>Grade Book</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • While assignment and quiz columns are maintained in the eLearning Grade Book, Custom Grade Book columns may not convert and may need to be recreated. • To access the eLearning Grade Book, under the Teach Tab, go to Instructor Tools and choose Grade Book.

Course Area	Details
Homepage becomes Course Content Home	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Homepage elements that migrate include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Organizer pages ○ Upper and lower textblocks (In eLearning, these are called headers and footers.) ○ Custom icons ○ Column layout ○ Links to content items • HTML in Homepage Page: HTML code in homepage or organizer page links in WebCT may remain in titles fields in eLearning, but might need to be reviewed and revised or removed. • Page Display Layout: Page display may be set to “Custom Layout” and may not appear the way you would like. To change page display layout (possibly set to “Custom Layout” initially), click Customize Page Display and select another page layout option.
Image Database tool becomes a collection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Although some links may need to be reviewed and revised, WebCT image databases become collections in the eLearning Media Library. You can add links to a specific Media Library collection from a folder or learning module.
Language Selector tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You can select course language in eLearning by choosing Manage Course > Settings > Administration > International.
Links and Icons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • E-Pack Links: Some WebCT courses use a “_COURSEID_” variable in course links. To make these links work in eLearning, remove the variable. <i>Note: Course ID variable links are often found in publisher content (e-packs). If you have a lot of links to repair, you may find it easier to start over with a Vista 4 version of your e-pack if one is available.</i> • Tool Links: Links to tools now appear on the course menu under Course Tools. • Link Text and Icons: To change the text of most links on your new folder pages (home page), use the Customize Link option instead of Edit Properties. Customize Link is also where changes to icons can be made.
Mail tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Mail tool is added to the course menu under Course Tools. Mail messages that were in the WebCT course are not imported into the eLearning section.

Course Area	Details
Manage files becomes File Manager tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All folders and files migrate from WebCT to eLearning and can be explored through the File Manager, added to the course menu under Designer Tools. • Your import files are automatically saved in My Files. This file storage area is accessible in all of your eLearning sections from a section's File Manager or from My eLearning > Content Manager Tab.
My Grades tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The My Grades tool is added to the course menu. From the Student View tab, choose My Tools > My Grades.
My Progress tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The My Progress tool is added to the course menu. From the Student View tab, choose My Tools > My Progress.
Organizer Pages becomes Folders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HTML in Organizer Page: HTML code in homepage or organizer page links in WebCT may remain in titles fields in eLearning, but might need to be reviewed and revised or removed. • Page Display Layout: Page display may be set to "Custom Layout" and may not appear the way you would like. To change page display layout (possibly set to "Custom Layout" initially), click Customize Page Display and select another page layout option.
Question Database	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All questions and categories migrate to the Questions Database located in Assessments.
Quizzes/Surveys tool becomes the Assessments tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Assessments tool is added to the course menu under Course Tools. All quizzes and questions migrate. If your WebCT course contained links from an organizer page to a specific subset of quizzes and surveys, this has migrated to a folder containing links. If the links need to be relocated to another course area, it may be helpful to simply recreate the links in eLearning, if moving the links proves problematic. • If your quizzes contained information in upper and lower text blocks, you can put this information in the description area of the quiz properties. • WebCT quiz categories referenced in at least one question used in a quiz will be migrated to eLearning. If the WebCT course contains questions in categories not included in any quiz, these categories may need to be recreated in eLearning or a temporary quiz containing one of the questions may need to be created in WebCT in order for the category to migrate to eLearning.

Course Area	Details
Selective Release	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If any of your course items were in selective release in WebCT, they are Hidden in eLearning.
Single Pages become links on folder pages	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Links from an organizer page to a single page migrate as files on folder pages.
Student Homepages tool becomes an Assignment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Content from Student Homepages becomes an assignment titled Student Home Page. The Assignments tool is added to the course menu, under Course Tools. Links from organizer pages now go to the Student Home Pages assignment.
Student Presentations tool becomes an Assignment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Content in the Student Presentations tool becomes a group assignment titled Student Presentations. The Assignments tool is added to the course menu under Course Tools. All group names and descriptions migrate to the Group Manager tool (see the Teach tab). Links from an organizer page to Student Presentations now go to the Student Presentations assignment.
Student Tips tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tips, reminders, and announcements can brought to students using the eLearning Announcements Tool.
Syllabus Tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Syllabus data migrates, although the course and instructor information may need to be reviewed and revised. The Syllabus tool is added to the course menu under Course Tools. • Note: If the WebCT course contained the syllabus on the home page, but not on the Course Menu, the eLearning Syllabus Tool can be made available through Manage Course > Tools.
URLs appear where linked and inside the Web Links tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • URLs (Links to web sites) migrate to eLearning and are automatically added to the Web Links tool appears under the course menu under Course Tools.
Whiteboard tool becomes a part of Chat	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Whiteboard is integrated with Chat. A room named "Whiteboard" is created. The Chat and Whiteboard tool is added to the course menu under Course Tools.
