

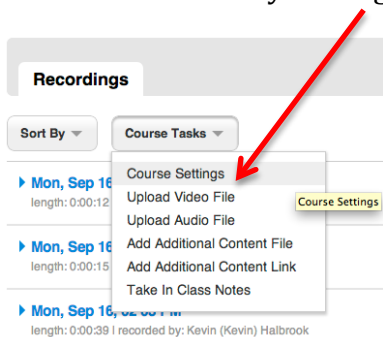
## Disabling Student Downloading

By default, Tegrity allows students to download recordings in a variety of formats. This gives students the ability to view recorded lectures on their mobile devices, and allows them save recordings for later viewing when an Internet connection may not be available. While these settings are intended to provide students with the greatest number of possible delivery options, faculty with intellectual property concerns may wish to disable these downloading options.

*Note: Please familiarize yourself with all applicable copyright laws before uploading any content that you did not personally create.*

### Disabling Alternate Delivery Options

1. From inside your Tegrity course, click on the **Course Tasks** button and select **Course Settings**.



2. Deselect all of the options listed under **Delivery** and then click **OK**.

### Course Settings

#### Recording

- Enable minute counter
- Allow students to record

#### Publishing

- Publish recordings after upload
- Automatically publish student recordings
- Require authentication by default for direct recording links
- Make this course publicly visible

#### Delivery

- Allow students to download recordings
- Enable MP3 Podcast
- Enable Video Podcast
- Enable video streaming to iOS and Android apps
- Enable RSS feed
- Disable student printing
- Enable audio search (read the Help prior to use)
- Enable Webcast
- Post recordings to Twitter ([Connect](#))
