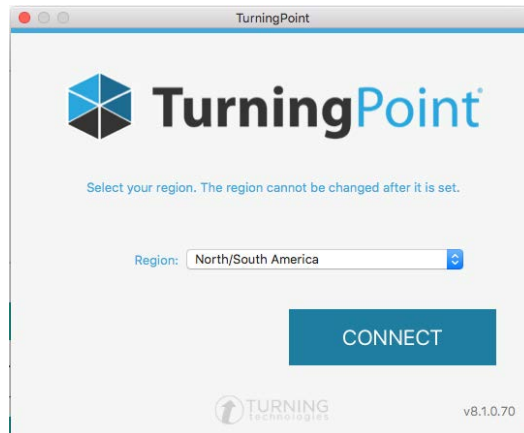


TurningPoint – PowerPoint Polling for Mac During Class

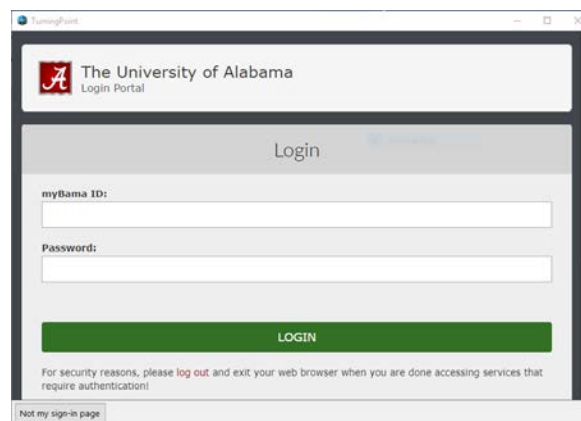
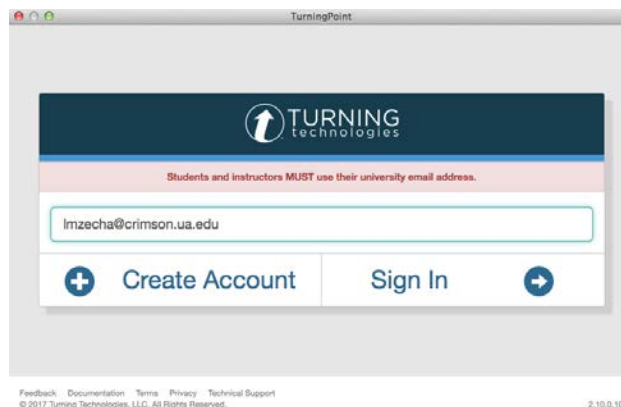
The TurningPoint PowerPoint Polling clicker system allows instructors to ask questions within PowerPoint on a Mac and receive student clicker responses. This tutorial will guide you through using PowerPoint Polling after TurningPoint has been installed on your computer.

Begin by opening the TurningPoint software application.


***Note:** If this is the first time you've opened the TurningPoint software, you will have to select North/South America. Click **Connect**.

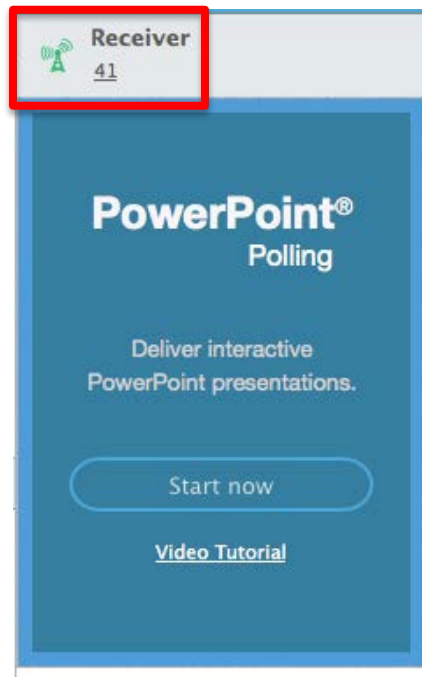


Enter your myBama email address and click **Sign In**. On the next screen, enter your myBama username and password and click **Login**.

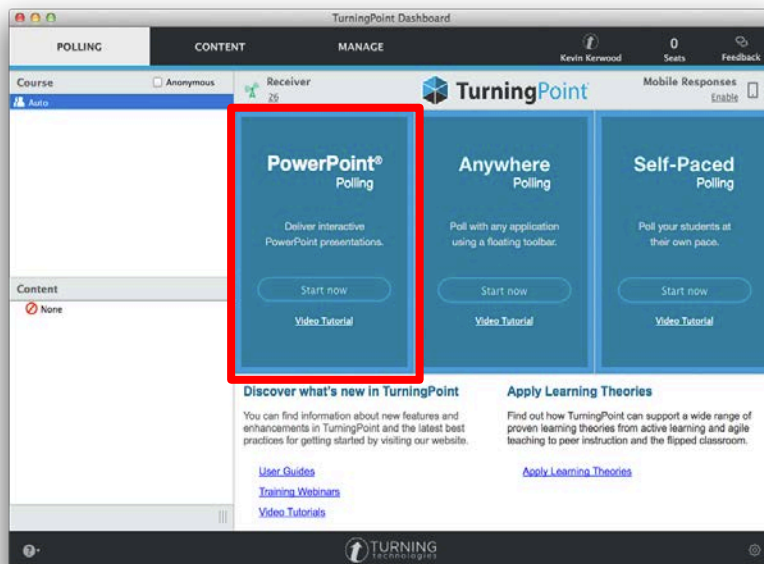


Presentation Polling

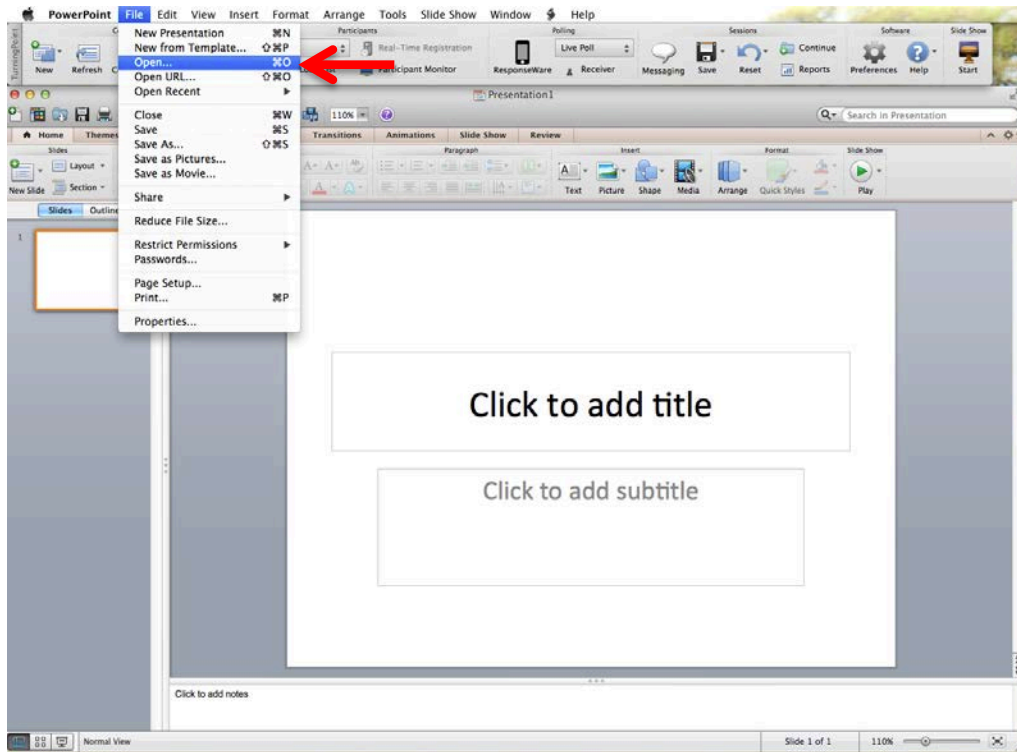
1. Open the TurningPoint application. 
2. Ensure that the Turning Technologies clicker receiver is plugged into a USB port. Verify the connection and channel number on the TurningPoint dashboard.



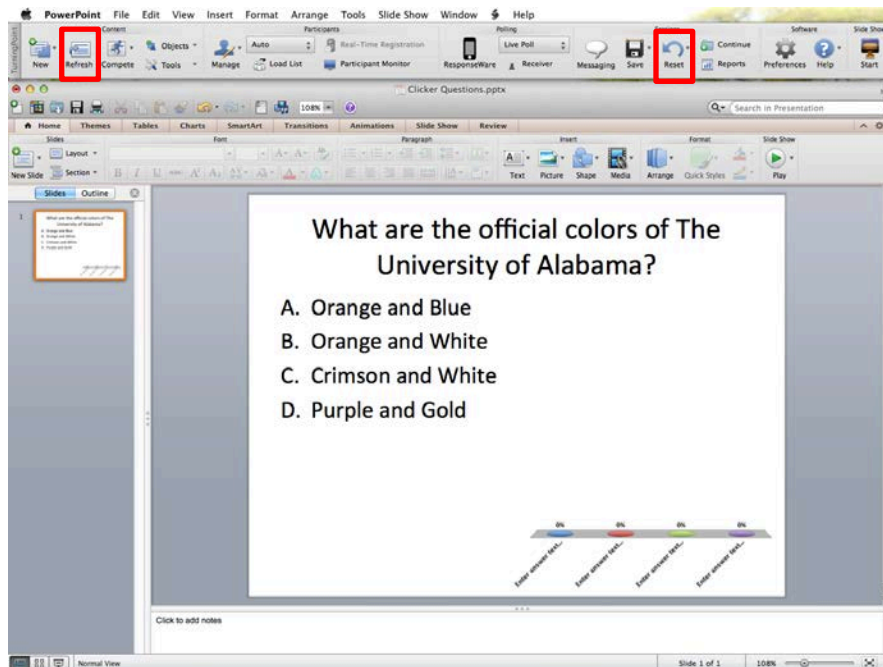
3. Click on the **PowerPoint Polling** option in TurningPoint.



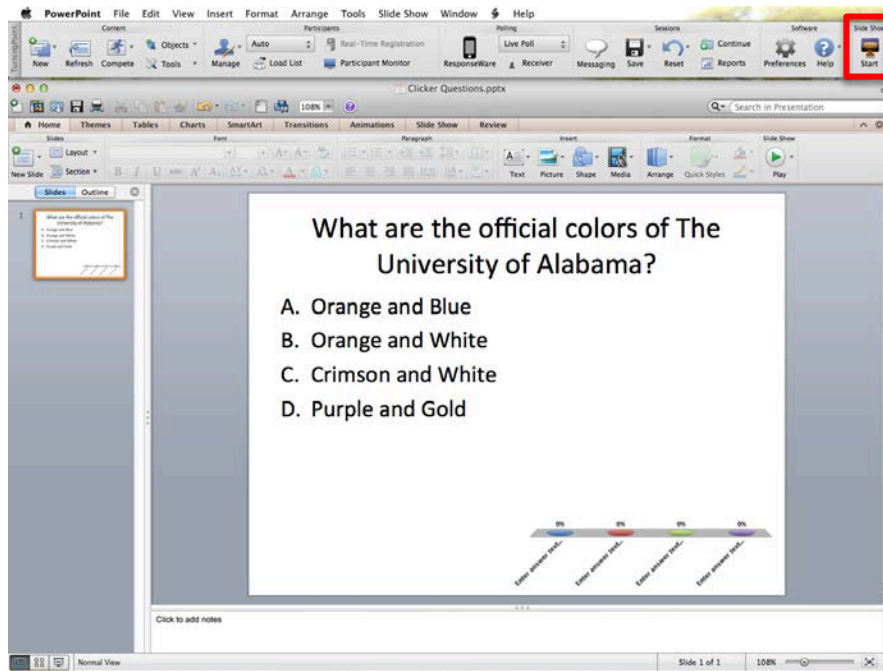
4. Click **File** and **Open** to open the file from your flash drive or share drive.



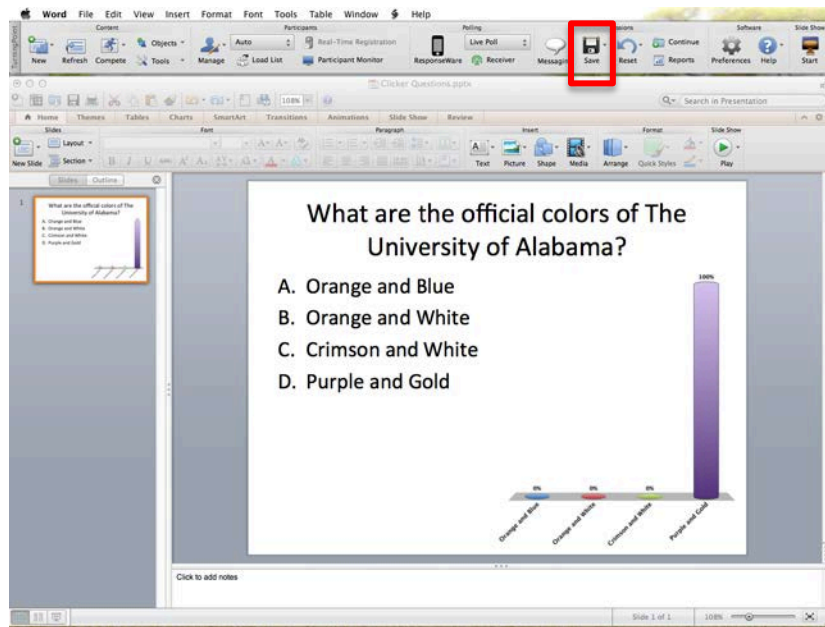
5. Before running the presentation, **Refresh** the session and then **Reset** the session to ensure that polling will open. [All graphs will reset to 0%.]



6. Press Start on the TurningPoint toolbar at the top of the screen.



7. After the presentation, click **Save** on the TurningPoint toolbar to save the session data. **Save** the session to a thumb drive or share drive.
